

The **Kentucky Poison Control Center (KPCC)**, in Louisville, KY, has **two** positions open for an RN, CSPI. Both positions are full time with one working **four 10 hour shifts** and the other working **three 12 hour shifts** per week. The position is **primarily for evenings** with occasional rotation to days and includes every other weekend. The KPCC was founded in 1954 and enjoys an excellent relationship with our state health department and parent organization, Norton Healthcare.



In addition to the PCC hotline, we also provide an HIV warm-line and opioid crisis hotline to the state of the KY. We manage about 45,000 poison center cases per year. We host medical professional student rotators from University of Louisville, University of KY, and Sullivan College of Pharmacy. We conduct regular case conferences and staff meetings for CSPI continuing education.

You must be licensed in KY or through a multi-state license that includes KY. AAPCC certification precludes the need to obtain CE for nursing license renewal in KY. Employment and generous benefits are offered through Norton Healthcare, one of the leading healthcare organizations in KY. Although we do offer a hybrid teleworking capability, this is not a 100% remote position and successful applicants must be willing to relocate to a local residence.

We are located along the Ohio River, directly across from Southern Indiana – In addition to our local attractions including great food, beautiful parks, and the nationally recognized KY Derby, we are within easy driving distance to major cities including Cincinnati, Indianapolis, and Nashville.
