






**Case Counts

Gender Distribution Disinfectant Cases (1/1/20 - 9/27/20)

Male	10,472	45.7%
Female	12,225	53.4%
Unknown	212	0.9%

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Results: According to data retrieved from the National Poison Data System (NPDS), there were 22,909 Disinfectant exposure cases reported to the 55 U.S. Poison Control Centers (Jan. 1, 2020 through Sep. 27, 2020), which resulted in an increase of 51% compared to the same time period during the previous year.
