The MiPCC is recruiting for a dynamic and capable Director who will be responsible for providing comprehensive leadership and oversight to the Michigan Poison Control Center. This person will be responsible for planning and managing daily operations at the Poison Center including SPI and PIP supervision and assisting in professional and layperson education, budget calculations and fund raising, maintaining staff quality assurance and helping with clinical operations. The Director will work closely with the Medical Director. This is a new academic position with Wayne State and the Director will work with the Medical Director and report to the Academic Chair of the Department of Emergency Medicine.

The Wayne State transition opens a bright new chapter in the Michigan Poison Center. The Director will directly influence the future direction of the Poison Center and the practice of toxicology in the state. It is an excellent opportunity to make your mark on the shape of the future.
