



Results: According to data retrieved from the National Poison Data System (NPDS), there were 587 Disinfectant exposure cases reported to the 55 U.S. Poison Control Centers (Jan. 1, 2021 through Jan. 10, 2021), which resulted in an increase of 9% compared to the same time period during the previous year.
