



Results: According to data retrieved from the National Poison Data System (NPDS), there were 20,958 Disinfectant exposure cases reported to the 55 U.S. Poison Control Centers (Jan. 1, 2020 through Aug. 30, 2020), which resulted in an increase of 55% compared to the same time period during the previous year.
