Since 1970, the Georgia Poison Center (GPC) has operated the 24-hour poison emergency treatment information service, providing assistance and expertise in the medical diagnosis and management of human and animal poisonings. Our AAPCC-certified poison center covers Georgia's 10.8 million residents and is housed at Atlanta's Grady Health System under the supervision of the Department of Pediatrics of Emory University School of Medicine. The Center is staffed with a dedicated group of highly trained professionals including medical and clinical toxicologists, registered nurses, registered pharmacists, health educators, and IT specialists. Our center is associated with an active inpatient medical toxicology service, 3 fellowship programs, and participates with training nursing, pharmacy, and medical students.

Competitive salary, benefits and telework options offered. Graduate of an accredited school of nursing, accredited school pharmacy, or medical school is required.
